The mission of the Philadelphia Arts in Education Partnership (PAEP) is to promote learning in and through the arts for students in K-12 schools throughout southeastern Pennsylvania. We accomplish this by working with teachers, teaching artists, school districts, colleges and universities, and 82 arts and cultural institutions throughout the region to encourage excellence in art-in-education practices, and to bring arts-based learning experiences to students who otherwise would have limited access to these opportunities.

Attend cultural events and receive Act 48 Credits

The Philadelphia Arts in Education Partnership is offering two ways for all K-12 teachers throughout Philadelphia, Bucks, Chester, Delaware, and Montgomery counties to attend programs at participating performing and visual arts institutions and receive Act 48 Credit. And, tickets are tax-deductible!

Program I: Attend any 5 cultural events and write a short paper for 25 Act 48 Credit hours. Just follow these easy steps to enroll:

1. Register with PAEP by completing and mailing in the registration form. Enclose a check for \$35 or credit card information to process all *Explore the Arts* Act 48 Credits. You pay that fee only once a year.
2. Select from the list below the performing or visual arts venues you wish to attend. Contact those organizations for program information and ticket sales.
3. Purchase a tax-deductible subscription series or a tax-deductible single ticket directly from the participating institutions. You may attend all five events from a single provider or you may mix and match to suit your interests.
4. Write a 1-2 page paper for each arts experience emphasizing its application to your classroom.
5. Submit your ticket stubs along with your written assignments to PAEP.
6. Receive 25 hours of Act 48 Credit at the completion of the course.

Explore the Arts runs from September 2007 through June 2008

Program II: For those who prefer to attend workshops or seminars, select from the list of arts providers offering performances with mandatory workshops or seminars. Just follow these easy steps to enroll:

1. Register with PAEP by completing and mailing in the registration form. Enclose a check for \$35 or credit card information to process all *Explore the Arts* Act 48 Credits. You pay that fee only once a year.
2. Select the performing arts venues you wish to attend. Contact those organizations' education departments for program information and ticket sales.
3. Purchase a tax-deductible ticket or tickets including the cost of the required workshop(s) directly from the participating institutions. Each institution participating in this version of *Explore the Arts* will bundle performances and mandatory workshops in different ways. PAEP will assign Act 48 Credit hours accordingly.
4. Attend the performance(s) and the workshop(s) of the arts organizations you want. Those organizations will coordinate with PAEP all necessary paperwork for you to receive the appropriate Act 48 Credit hours. PAEP does not guarantee the availability of appropriate workshops and performances. These workshops and performances are provided at the option of the arts organization.
